2026 Eligibility Criteria for Applicants to the College Degree Program Graduating from International High-School Systems

Saudi Aramco's aim is to attract high-caliber students, whether they graduate from an in-Kingdom or an out-of-Kingdom school. Saudi applicants from in-Kingdom and out-of-Kingdom high schools that have adopted international high-school educational systems can apply for the program. Their applications are considered on a case-by-case basis.

To sit for the College Degree Program screening tests and be considered for the program, all applicants must meet minimum requirements that are based on high school performance and standardized aptitude test results.

2026 applicants will be required to meet all of the three following criteria:

- 1.** A Scientific Qudurat/General Aptitude Test (GAT) score of 90 or higher
[ONLY the Scientific Qudurat/GAT score is acceptable]
OR a Math score on SAT of 630 or higher
OR a Math score on ACT of 27 or higher
- 2.** A High-School Cumulative GPA of 85.00% or higher
- 3.** A High-School Math & Science Cumulative GPA of 85.00% or higher

Note that GPAs are computed for grades 9, 10, 11, and the first term of grade 12 based on candidates' high-school transcripts.

All candidates must have his/her diploma authenticated by the appropriate government authorities, indicating the equivalency of his/her diploma to the Saudi Arabian government high school certificate.
