Standardized tests are designed in such a way that the questions, conditions for administering, scoring procedures, and interpretations are consistent and are administered and scored in a predetermined, standard manner. Sometimes these are referred to as external exams, provincial exams, state exams, national exams, etc. and are typically designed to measure student achievement or English language proficiency).</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Copies of current immunization records (Acceptable records are: immunization certificates, immunization (shot) cards, hospital records, and certification by a physician on prescription forms or letterhead) or a medical exemption letter from a physician stating which vaccine(s) the student is exempt from and any information the school should have regarding the health concern.
