



Change to Dhahran commissary hours

The Saudi Government has issued a 24-hour per day curfew that applies to specified Saudi Aramco communities, with the exception of leaving for absolutely necessary reasons, such as purchasing food and obtaining medical care, and only between 6 a.m. and 3 p.m.

To help employees and community members, Community Services has introduced some new changes to make shopping for necessities easier.

New operating hours of Dhahran commissaries:

- > Dhahran Commissary: 6 a.m. - 3 p.m. JHAH employees will be given priority between 6-7 a.m. by showing their JHAH ID card.
- > Munirah Commissary: 6 a.m. - 3 p.m. From 3 p.m. to 6 p.m., Al-Munirah Commissary will be open for Saudi Aramco and JHAH employees who live in local communities to shop before going home.
- > >DH Hills Mini Market: 7 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
- > >Al-Midra Mini Market: 8 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
- > >North Admin Mini Market: 8 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
- > >DOB Mini Market: 8 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
- > >Al-Rabiya Mini Market: 8 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
