We are consolidating all official Company information on COVID-19 to ensure our workforce has the latest and most accurate information. You will be receiving frequent updates as information becomes available.

our people

We are instituting measures to minimize the spread of the virus, and limiting exposure

- Employees with preexisting health conditions were released from work for 14 days.
- Various awareness messages in at least four languages and different forms have been distributed across our facilities and disseminated to our employees, dependents, and contractors, to ensure proper hygiene and precautionary measures are taken by our people.
- Saudi Aramco maintains continuous communication with its students abroad to ensure their well-being.
- Saudi Aramco has shut down its major training programs and facilities (e.g., ITC, CPC, Driving Schools, Expat Schools) to reduce the exposure risk of our in-Kingdom students. Virtual learning has commenced.
- Saudi Aramco has repatriated more than 300 employees, dependents, and students from high-risk areas to Saudi Arabia.
- Launched a 24/7 HR Helpdesk.

Crisis drills and facility disinfections

- Business continuity plans activated for all Saudi Aramco organizations.
- Increased frequency of office and facility disinfection.
- Non-essential transportation routes (buses and flights) cancelled.
- Limited bus passengers on workhaul transportation to ensure sufficient distance between bus users.
- Readiness – An increased frequency of drills and preparedness exercises is taking place throughout various facilities and office buildings. Please expect drills to take place in your area and support the readiness teams in their efforts.
- Launched mandatory e-learning to raise awareness on preventing the spread of COVID-19.
- Majority of Company workstations now have Skype for Business, reducing the need for physical meetings.

- Community and Office Services continue to conduct hundreds of routine disinfections in high-traffic locations throughout our communities.
- Community Services has stocked extra supplies of fast-moving items for our commissaries.
